


Formal Remittances Inflows

Remittances Inflows as a Share of Selected Financial Flows and GDP, 2009

Remittances flows constitute an important source of foreign exchange for developing economies. Comparing remittances to other financial inflows displays the extent to which remittances contribute to a country's inflow of foreign exchange.






